

Old Spanish Trail Music Festival - Tickets on Sale Now! (Vendors Get Free Tickets!)

The Monte Arts Council will host the first Old Spanish Trails Music Festival on Saturday, August 23. The musical event – set for 11 a.m. to 8 p.m. at Ski Hi Park in Monte Vista – will feature folk, country, blues and salsa musicians from throughout Colorado and New Mexico. Headliners will include the country band, The Yampa Valley Boys; folk and blues chanteuse Gabrielle Louise; and Savor, a New Mexico-based salsa band that will offer a 30-minute dance lesson before their performance.

Other entertainers include country musician Fritz Davis; folk, jazz and pop artist, Robin James; “cowpoke folk” entertainer Fred Hargrove; ukuleist Mike Bork; and Crestone’s Late Bloom.

The festival will also host art, craft, merchant and food vendors on site. Vendor applications are available at the MAC website or by calling 719-850-0114. Tickets may be purchased at various locations, including the Monte Vista Information Center and online at www.montearts.com. Vendors receive three (3) free tickets with their booth fees. MAC vendors receive four (4) free tickets and a reduced booth fee.

Ticket prices are \$12 per person (\$10 for MAC members) and \$48 for five tickets (\$40 for MAC members).
